<p>How to apply</p>	<p>Full information is available on the ESADSE web-site https://www.esadse.fr/en/registration/190116-etudier-a-l-esadse-study-at-esadse</p> <p>Your school/university must nominate you before the nomination deadline.</p> <p>After this, student will have to send to the ESADSE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Dully completed application form; - a portfolio (5 projects, PDF File, 5Mo maximum); - a CV; - a motivation letter; - an ID photograph (JPEG, 2 Mo maximum).
<p>Selection Criteria</p>	<p>Your selection will be decided with the two coordinators (Art and Design) and will be based on your portfolio and your motivation letter.</p>
<p>Language Requirements</p>	<p>As lectures are mostly given in French, a good knowledge of French is highly recommended. The French Language Knowledge Test (TCF) is also recommended.</p> <p>The school requires all students to produce evidence of their English ability (B2 level)</p> <p>French courses are given throughout the year (2 hours/week) at ESADSE.</p>
<p>Specifications</p>	<p>You have important administrative steps to follow when arriving at ESADSE. The administrative registration consists in filling a registration file (at the international affairs department) and the educational registration consists in choosing your courses (meeting with the coordinators & teachers of the school).</p> <p>First, come to the international affairs department with all the required documents for registration: insurance, liability insurance, copy of ID, copy of home student card</p>
<p>The reply from the ESADSE</p>	<p>Students receive the reply regarding their application within a month after the application deadline.</p>

Student Visa

Visa Procedure	<p>Depending on their nationality, students should obtain entry clearance to France before leaving home. Students coming from the European Union usually only need to show a valid passport or identity card.</p> <p>Students from the rest of the world need to apply to their nearest French Embassy or Consulate for a visa.</p> <p><u>Be careful:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A touristic visa can't be changed into a student visa. • French visa can't be modified once arrived. • Non-European foreign students staying more than 3 months must obtain a "student residence permit", different from the visa & the deadline to obtain it is 2 months after arrival.
Required documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport • Proof of registration at home institution • Proof of real financial resources • Return tickets (for stay <6 months) • Copy of social insurance • Copy of diplomas.

Expenses

Costs of Living Expenses (€)	Between 200 and 500€/month for accommodation Between 100 and 200€/month for food Tramway and bus tickets: 1.40€ for 1 hour
Extra costs to be considered (€)	A cinema entrance: around 8€ A coffee in a restaurant: 2€ A museum entrance: can be free for students or around 5-10€ A train ticket to Lyon: 10€ A train ticket to Paris: 70€ (price depending on the day)
