<p>Programmes open for exchange studies</p> <p>In general, all our programmes in Design, Crafts and Applied Art on BA and MA level are open for exchange studies. Check the link to be sure. On MA level study-places for exchange students are very restricted.</p> <p>Students will follow the courses within the programme they are accepted to. In some cases, an individual study-plan will be conducted after discussion with the Programme director upon arrival. Contact the Exchange Institutional Coordinator for more information.</p> <p>Teachers Education Program has special rules for admission and can only accept exchange students at certain semesters. <p>Selection and admission</p>	<p>Applicants will be selected after evaluation of submitted material. HDK reserves the right to assess incoming students' suitability for specific programme based on their application materials. Students cannot be guaranteed a study-place before the admissions committee has considered their applications. Decision about admission will be sent within 6 weeks after the application deadline.</p>
<p>Language of Study</p>	<p>Mainly English. On BA level, some lectures will be held in Swedish. With good knowledge in English, there will be no problem to follow the studies for exchange students. On MA level, the teaching language is English. Good knowledge of English is essential. It is the responsibility of the sending school to make sure that the students English language skills are sufficient.</p>

Welcome programme and recommended arrival dates	<p>Welcome programme and pick-up service will be arranged a couple of days before the start of the semester.</p> <p>Accepted students will be informed about the Welcome programme by email.</p>
Accommodation	<p>We cannot guarantee accommodation for incoming students; however the Student Housing Service at University of Gothenburg will give support. Since it can be hard to find a place to stay in Gothenburg, it is recommended to use this service.</p> <p>Once your online application is submitted you will receive a confirmation email with a link to the housing application.</p> <p>Students accepted for studies for HDK at Steneby will get support from the departmental coordinator in Dals Långed.</p>
